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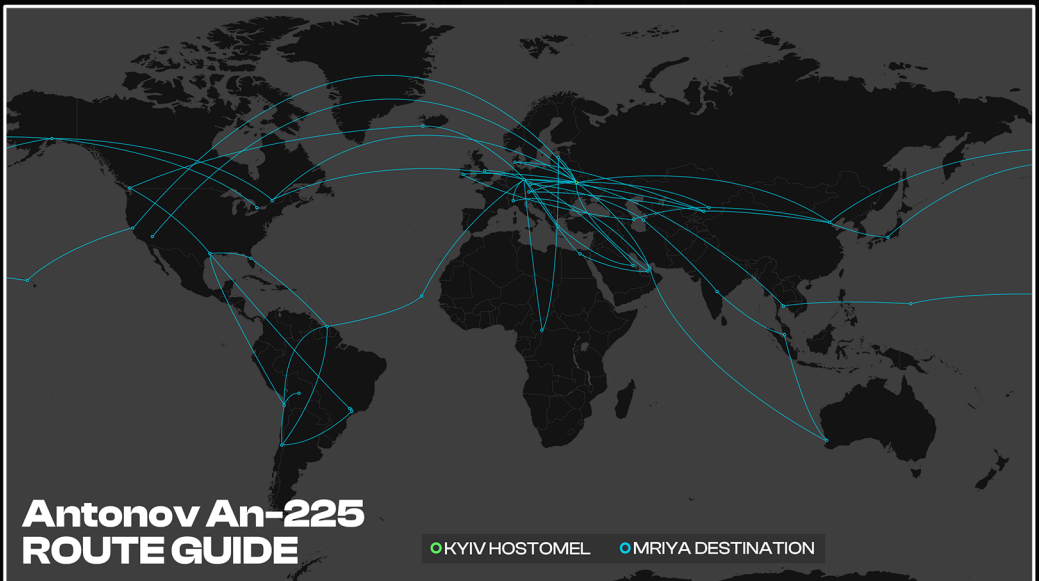


Introduction

Welcome to the Microsoft Antonov An-225 Route Guide. This document will cover day to day, charter, and significant flights operated by the An-225 (UR-82060). From flying relief equipment to Guam, to hauling generators to Bolivia. The Antonov An-225 could carry almost anything with it's maximum takeoff weight of 640,000 kilograms.

Most data for this Route Guide has been taken from Flightradar24's history of UR-82060, as well as Flightradar24's blog post about the An-225's flight schedule from the past. Please note this data may not be 100% accurate and some sectors are missing from the Route Guide due to the lack of information of certain flights.

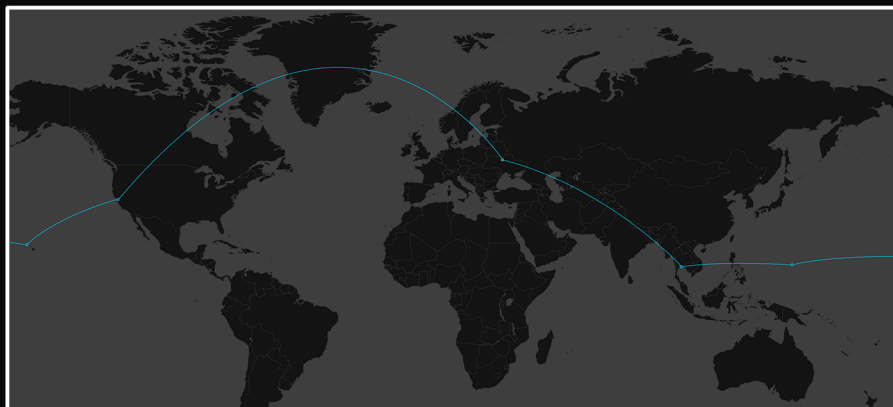

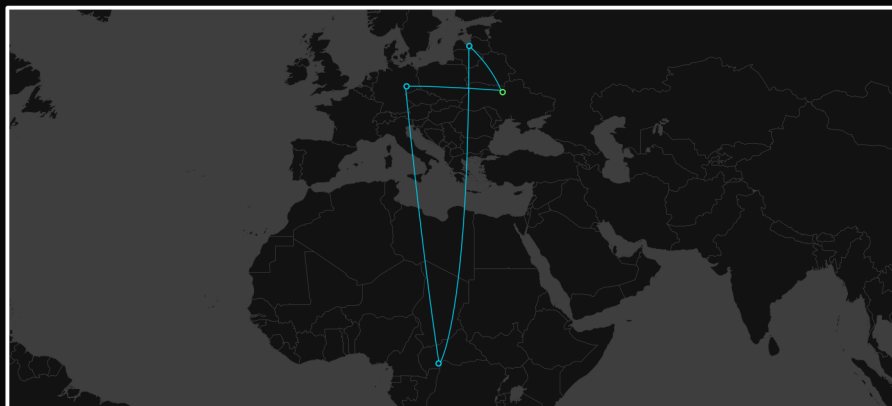
Bangui Mission
